First Annual Senior Games Closing Ceremony The first annual Jersey City Senior Games was hosted by Mayor Steven Fulop and the Jersey City Resident Response Center. The games started on Oct. 24 and lasted through Oct. 29. Activities such as basketball, billiards, and line dancing were included in the games. The closing ceremony was held at City Hall on Nov 8. During the closing ceremony Mayor Steven Fulop honored 80 participants and 10 medals were given out.
