

EVALUATION CRITERIA FOR EMERGENCY SHELTER GRANT (ESG)

Category	Rating	Brief Description
Need for Project	20%	Degree to which project is addressing City's Consolidated Plan priorities and extent to which project will alleviate community needs (objectives of the project).
Capacity of Agency	30%	Ability to effectively administer public service project (i.e., qualified personnel) and ability to provide adequate source documentation for low- and moderate-income persons served.
Project Implementation	15%	Degree to which applicant has a clear plan to achieve Consolidated Plan priorities (methodology), collaborations with other agencies and degree to which project agency can track performance measurements.
Project Readiness	10%	Degree to which applicant is prepared to proceed with project.
Financial Viability of Applicant	25%	Degree to which agency has demonstrated financial soundness to meet project objectives.
