In effort to improve the reliability of PSE&G's underground electrical network system in Jersey City, PSE&G has recently completed an electrical upgrade project throughout the surrounding area of downtown Jersey City. The final road restoration work associated with this project will be completed on or about 11/28/2011. The restoration work will be completed in one day. The work will take place on Mercer Street between Varick Street and Marin Blvd and Stueben Street to Warren Street to Morgan Street.

This investment by PSEG is part of an ongoing effort to meet growing demand for safe, reliable power. The work involved upgrading the existing primary cables with new cables and man hole and conduit system.

PSE&G is the winner of the Reliability One Award for superior electric system reliability in America for four of the past five years and for the last eight consecutive years in the Mid-Atlantic region. This work is necessary to maintain that excellent standard.
