HURRICANE SANDY PARKING ENFORCEMENT

Vehicles damaged and made inoperable by Hurricane Sandy must be removed from City streets. **If your auto has been damaged by Sandy and your adjuster has not yet examined your vehicle, the City is offering free towing and storage for up to fifteen (15) days at the Phillips Street impound lot. Your car will only be towed if you call.**

This service should afford your adjuster ample opportunity to examine your auto and determine if repair is feasible.

Storage fees of \$30 per day will commence on the sixteenth day of storage. The Phillips Street impound lot will be open Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 5:30 PM and Saturday from 8:00 AM to 3:30 PM. **Anyone who cannot move their car will be subject to parking regulations that resume on Monday November 19th.**

You must contact the Jersey City Parking Authority to take advantage of this offer. Towing will begin on or about 11/19/12 and be completed by 11/30/12. **Please call the Parking Authority at (201) 653-6969, ext. 110 to schedule the towing of your vehicle.**



If you do not contact the Parking Authority to arrange towing and your vehicle is subsequently towed you will be liable for the standard towing fee of \$150.00 and \$30.00 per day storage fee.
