

DUNCAN AVENUE SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS

Route 1&9 to West Side Avenue



Construction Completion: October 2023

SAFETY ELEMENTS

The City of Jersey City will be restriping Duncan Avenue between Route 1&9 and West Side Avenue to install a parking-protected two-way bikeway along with curb extensions to enhance pedestrian safety. The project will include safety enhancements at the entrances to Lincoln Park and the introduction of loading zones along the corridor.

CONSTRUCTION PLAN

Construction of the improvements will begin on or about October 3, 2023. Minor detours of traffic may be instituted during the striping operation. Parking will be prohibited and emergency no parking signage will be posted within the project limits on a rolling basis. Vehicles parking within the project limits will be towed at the owner's expense. The project is anticipated to be completed in October 2023.
