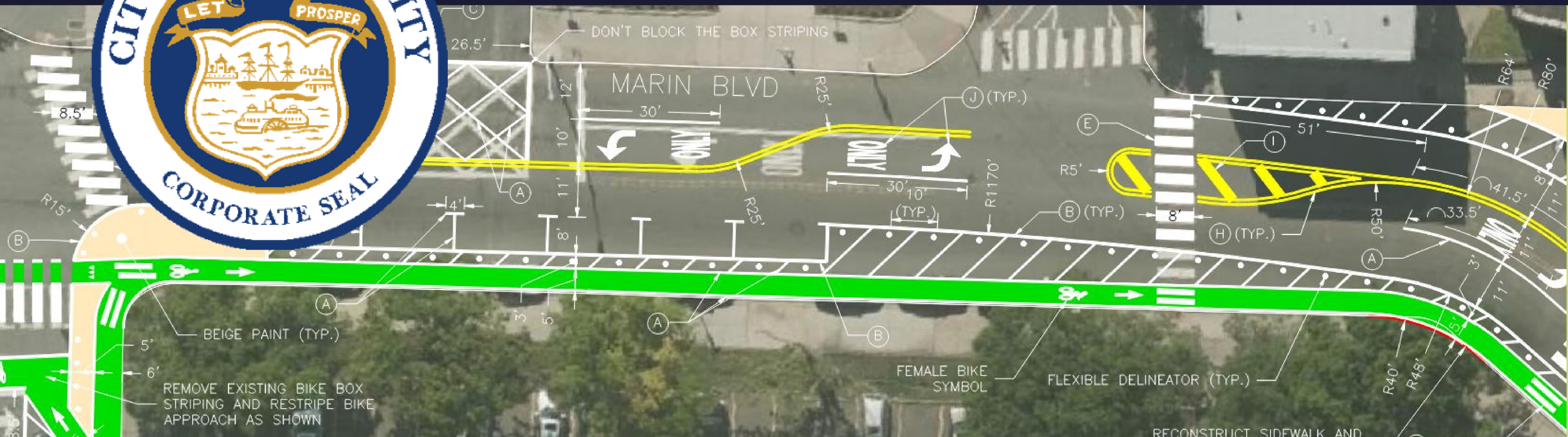


MARIN BLVD SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS

Montgomery Street to 6th Street (Thomas Gangemi Drive)



Construction Completion: August 2023

SAFETY ELEMENTS

The City of Jersey City will be restriping Marin Boulevard between Montgomery Street and 6th Street (Thomas Gangemi Drive) to install a parking-protected northbound bike lane along with curb extensions to enhance pedestrian safety. The restriping project follows the design of an upcoming Federal Local Safety Program project which will start construction in 2024.

CONSTRUCTION PLAN

Construction of the improvements will begin on or about July 24, 2023. Minor detours of traffic may be instituted during the striping operation. Parking will be prohibited and emergency no parking signage will be posted within the project limits on a rolling basis. Vehicles parking within the project limits will be towed at the owner's expense. The project is anticipated to be completed August 2023.
