The City of Jersey City is looking for a licensed Electrical Inspector that will be responsible for inspecting new and existing buildings and structures to ensure compliance with the State Uniform Construction Code as well as to ensure public safety, health, and welfare,

Job Duties:

- Examines and approves plans and specifications for electrical work for compliance with the electrical subcode of the Uniform Construction Code
- Inspects and evaluates electrical work in construction projects for conformance with requirements of approved plans, and the electrical subcode and regulations of the New Jersey Uniform Construction Code
- Inspects electrical installations in existing buildings for conformance with the minimum safety standards incorporated in the regulations of the Uniform Construction Code and relevant laws within the jurisdiction
- Determines the cause of electrical or energy subcode violations and takes corrective action
- Initiates legal action against violators of electrical subcodes.
- Prepares essential reports and establishes and maintains essential records and files.
- May give assignments and instructions to employees and may supervise the performance of their work.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Requirements:

- Possession of a valid Electrical Inspector's License of the appropriate class issued by the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, (HHS)
- Possession of a valid New Jersey Driver's License

Essential Skills:

- Ability to analyze and interpret electrical installation codes
- Knowledge of structural and analysis techniques necessary to check compliance with the State Uniform Construction Code
- Knowledge of basic material standards, codes, and enforcement requirements related to the weatherability and durability of installed construction materials.
- Comprehension of basic fire protection requirements, tools, and test methods.
- Able to prepare violation notices and prescribed inspection record keeping,
- Ability to carry out provisions of the State Uniform Construction Code as they relate to residential and small commercial structures.
- Work harmoniously with other municipal unit heads and with private contractors and architects
- Capable of making investigations, inspections, and clear and concise reports.
- Ability to prosecute violations of the electrical code by appearing in court.
